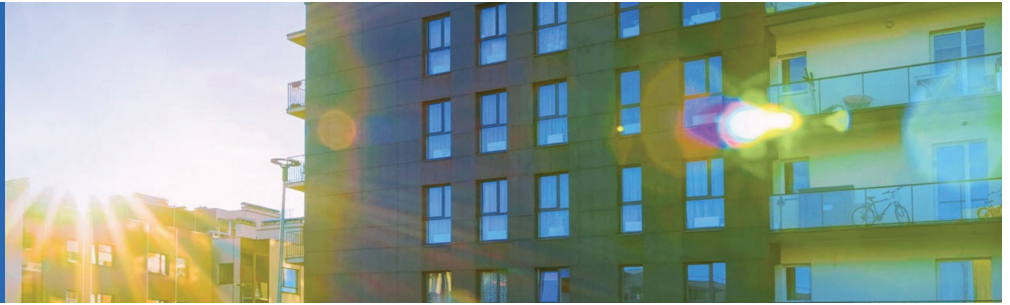


HB101 Places FAQs



Q WHAT IS HB101 PLACES ([MN.HB101.ORG/PLACES.HTM](https://mn.hb101.org/places.htm))?

A HB01 Places is a statewide online search tool for Minnesota Housing Support Programs vacancies (Housing Support formerly known as Group Residential Housing/GRH).

Some programs with services and some without.

People can browse available housing types, filter by specific services, and view a list of programs with or without vacancies or program openings.

HB101 Places includes six Housing Support program types:

- Adult Foster Care (AFC) and Community Residential Settings (CRS)
- Board and Lodge with and without services
- Assisted Living (Housing Support units)
- Site-based supportive housing
- Independent Community Settings (ICS)
- Scattered Site Community Settings

Q WHAT IS HOUSING SUPPORT?

A Housing Support is a Minnesota eligibility program for people with disabilities and older adults who have low income. It helps pay for housing and things people need to stay housed in certain group settings or in the community.

Q WHAT IF I AM A PERSON LOOKING FOR OTHER TYPES OF HOUSING AND HAVE QUESTIONS OR NEED MORE HELP?

Q I'M A PROVIDER, HOW CAN I GET LISTED ON HB101 PLACES?

- A** To be enrolled or have programs listed on the HB101 Places, providers need to be an authorized Housing Support provider through their local County or Tribal Government.
- If you are an authorized Housing Support provider, please email your name, your organization's name, address and phone number to hb101.places.dhs@state.mn.us
 - The HB101 Places team will start the enrollment process for your provider level access
 - The HB101 Places team can also assist providers with questions they may have on their accounts located on the website

Q DO YOU HAVE TO PAY TO BE LISTED?

- A** No, listing Vacancies or Program Openings on HB101 Places is available for authorized Housing Support providers at no cost.

Q HOW ARE VACANCIES AND PROGRAM OPENINGS UPDATED?

- A** Providers update their own Vacancies or Program Openings directly into HB101 Places. Each entry has an updated date showing the last update.

Q IS HB101 PLACES ACCESSIBLE?

- A** HB101 and HB101 Places conforms to accessibility standards.
